Please read the following information to help answer questions about our upcoming audition process.

Will my child need to stay for the whole Audition Workshop?

The auditions are scheduled in 2 hour sessions. It is possible that we may finish early. If we do, a text message will be sent out to the number on file.

Does attending the audition assure my child a role in the production?

This really depends on the total number of kids auditioning. I am going to do my very best to try to find a spot for as many kids as I can. However, this is a very popular show and we are expecting a large turnout. If the audition numbers get too large we will have to make some cuts.

What does my child need to do for auditions?

There will be 3 parts to their audition. Acting, singing, and dancing. All of the material for the singing and acting will be available at finalbow.org/theatre beginning July 19th so they have time to learn the material for auditions. The dance audition will consist of your child learning a short dance routine at the auditions and performing it with a small group.

What should my child wear for auditions?

I suggest wearing something they can move well in. It is always good to dress nice for an audition but they also need to be able to move comfortably for the dance audition. If your child owns dance shoes (Ballet slippers, jazz shoes, or character shoes) feel free to send them for the dance audition.

Will my child have a chance to eat during the audition process?

Yes. You may also pack them a small snack to eat on their downtime.

Are parents allowed to watch auditions?

No, the audition will be closed and parents are asked to drop off their child and return at the conclusion of the workshop to pick up their child. We will have several adults the full workshop to supervise.

Does audition material need to be memorized?

It is not a requirement that material be memorized, however, 99.9% of the time students are able to appear to be more confident when they have their material memorized.

What will be expected if my child is called back?

We will only be calling a small number of students back, and only if needed. If your child is needed for a callback we will email all the material they need for their callback no later than August 2nd at 8:00. They will need to prepare that material for the second round.

If my child is cast in the show what will the rehearsal schedule look like?

The schedule will be set up so only specific parts will come on specific days. We will rehearse Monday and Thursday from 6-8 and Saturday 10:30-12:30. Once the cast has been selected they will receive a schedule detailing which days they need to attend rehearsal. Additional rehearsals may be added. Students must be available the full week of the show performances.

What is the total cost for my child to be in the production?

The tuition for Final Bow Company is \$75 per child.

When will the cast list be posted?

The cast list will be emailed as well as posted on the facebook page for Final Bow by August 14th.


